Her workshop, “Self-Care 2.0” has provided over 2,500 employees across 15 organizations, including the American Lung Association, Google, and the National Institutes of Health, with a science-based framework for understanding and responding to chronic stress. This innovative approach earned Rachel the “Trauma-Informed Care Champion” award for the City of Chicago in 2023.

Prior to her current work, Rachel spent 15 years as a leader in consumer marketing and the media, including as Editor-in-Chief of InStyle magazine in the Czech Republic. She’s passionate about a future that includes access to well-being for all people and will soon relocate to Washington DC to support others working towards a similar vision.

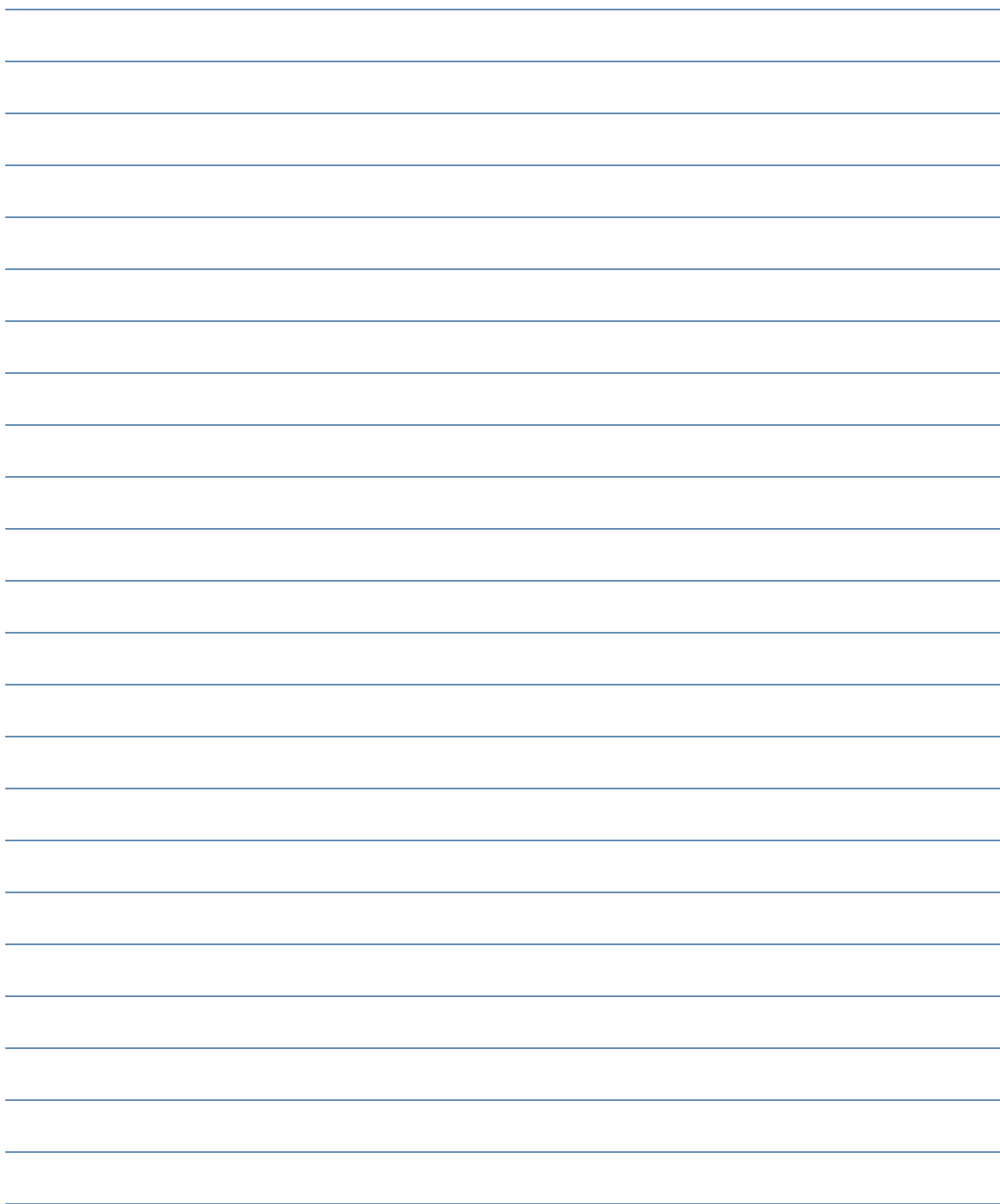
