
DATS

NIH Child Care Program provides a variety of child and adult dependent/elder care programs and resources to the NIH community.

NIH Back-Up Care Program

Federal Employees have access to back-up care when they need to be at work and their regular child or adult/elder care is unavailable. Back-up care programs include: center-based child care, in-home child care, in-home mildly ill child care, in-home adult/elder care, and self-care (when you need care).

NIH Child Care Subsidy Program

Federal Employees of the NIH may be eligible to receive a child care tuition subsidy if their children are enrolled in licensed child care programs and meet the income criteria.

The NIH Employee Transportation Services Office (ETSO) is located in Building 31, Room B3B04. Hours of operation are 7:30 am until 4:30 pm, Monday through Friday, excluding federal holidays. Services provided include: NIH Parking Permits, NIH Transshare & Bike Subsidy Programs and commuter information/help.

Parking on the NIH Main Campus can be very difficult. We strongly encourage multi-occupancy vehicles or employees to commute using mass transportation. Parking permits are issued according to NIH policy and guidelines. Not every NIH employee or contractor will qualify for a parking permit.

Visitor Parking / Parking Meters

The NIH also offers parking for visitors in designated lots around the campus. These lots consist of the P1 level of the Clinical Center, the MLP-11 (Gateway) Garage next to the NIH Gateway Center and the 4A Surface lot in between Buildings 4 & 2. There are also meters placed strategically around campus for visitor use. These meters accept pay by credit card. All visitor lots and meters charge a rate of \$2.00 per hour, with \$12.00 day maximum.



The DATS provides complimentary shuttle services for employees, visitors and patients. Shuttles are handicap accessible and are equipped with bike racks for convenience.

Shuttle routes are as follows:

Campus Shuttle, Campus Limited, Montrose, Executive Plaza, Rockledge, Campus Perimeter, Building 10 after hour shuttle, Children's Inn, Airport Shuttles to BWI, Regan National and Dulles.

Hotel shuttles are also available for patients.

The NIH Transhare Program is a transportation incentive program for NIH employees who are willing to use public transportation to commute to the NIH campus. The program includes a wide variety of alternative transportation modes such as vanpools, Metrorail, MARC Trains and public buses and commuter buses.

The transit subsidy is offered to NIH Employees, Fellows, Summer Students, and Volunteers. Any member who receives a transit subsidy must forfeit all parking permits or parking access cards and is not eligible to receive a bicycle subsidy. NIH provides the maximum subsidy allowable by IRS Tax codes.

The NIH Bicycle Commuter Subsidy Program is an incentive program for NIH employees who bike to the NIH campus daily. As with the NIH Transhare Program, participants cannot receive parking benefits to be eligible. Currently, the subsidy is \$20 per month, the maximum NIH is authorized to provide by IRS tax codes.

The DATS also encourages all cyclist to join the NIH Bicycle Commuter Club to meet many other "Zero Polluter Commuters!" To accommodate bike and walking commuters, shower facilities are located in many buildings on the main campus, as well as all fitness facilities. The NIH also provides over 1000 lockers spread throughout campus to provide commuters a place to change and store clothes for the day.

RideShare

The NIH Parking Office also offers a free RideShare service. The service attempts to match other commuters based on similar work times, home and work addresses.

Carpool

Employees and contractors that start commuting in one vehicle may qualify for a carpool parking permit. The carpool permits allows members to park in designated spaces that are close in to buildings and reserved for their use.

Vanpool

The NIH Parking Office assists commuters in finding and starting vanpools, which are a minimum of seven commuters in one vehicle. Vanpool riders may be eligible to receive mass transportation benefits (NIH Transshare Program) to subsidy the cost of the vanpool.
