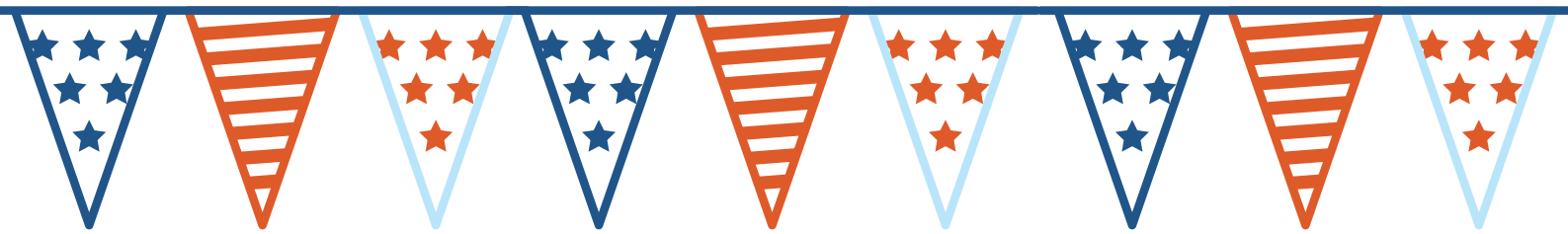


# Military Spouses Network
