In order to begin a rotation at Walter Reed National Military Medical Center, all students must complete a medical screening to be cleared medically by Occupational Health.

The required medical screenings are as follows:

- Review of medical history and immunizations
- 2-step Tuberculosis skin test (PPD) or single quantiferon blood test for students rotating in the hospital.
- Blood Test for immunity to measles, mumps, rubella, chicken pox, and hepatitis B; or proof of completed series, including tetanus/pertussis (DTAP or TDAP).
