The Division of Safety (DS) is pleased to announce that we will be utilizing the CITI Program for training staff that need to ship Category B biological specimens and dry ice. The CITI course is designed to meet requirements of IATA and the U.S. Department of Transportation (DOT). Note that we are in the process of acquiring a new vendor to provide Cat A training which should be available to the NIH community by this spring. If you complete the Cat B training through the CITI program, please send us your certificate of completion to orssafetytraining@mail.nih.gov and we will update your training record.
